Those in pews and chairs will be directed to communion at the altar rail, returning by the “one way” route. If you sit in the pews or chairs but find the chancel steps difficult, please ask a Welcomer to receive communion at your seat.

Communion is in both kinds. Intinction (dipping the wafer) is not permitted as the risk of germ/virus transmission by touching the wine with fingers is more likely than through the common cup.

Donations - We have a contactless ‘donation station’ near the West (main) Door with the facility for Gift Aid which saves the Gift Aid administration that donation envelopes require.
