Next Sunday is the launch of the new daily prayer diary, with a prayer for something in the local area each day of every month. In addition, during August, our Prayer and Share Group will be going Walkabout, with a series of 3 Prayer Walks to cover the whole of Herston. Everyone welcome.

Tuesday 6th August: Meet at St Mark's at 10am and we'll walk and pray for the residents of the Herston area east of St Mark's (Steer Road, Priests Road, Cow Lane, High Street, Kings Road West, Victoria Avenue and side roads). If wet, we'll stay at St Mark's.

Tuesday 13th August: Meet at St Mark's at 10am and we'll walk and pray for the residents of the area around St Mark's (Bell St, Marsh Way, Higher Days Road, Benlease Way, Jubilee Road and side roads). We'll also stop at Herston Village Green and pray for the residents of Herston Yards, and pray for Herston Village Hall in Jubilee Rd. If wet, we'll stay at St Mark's.

Tuesday 20th August: Meet at the bottom of Days Road, where it joins High Street, at 10am, and we'll walk and pray for the residents at the western end of St Mark's area (Days Rd, Sydenham Rd, Holmes Rd, High St and side roads) and also St Mark's School + Swanage School. If wet, we'll meet at Church.
